## 2020 Doctors in Recital Application

Doctors in Recital is a community event led by local physicians which raises funds to support area programs to improve the health, wellness and quality of life in Brown County. Funds are raised to support both a community nonprofit organization and a music education partner. These beneficiaries are selected at the start of the planning year through a competitive application process.

The community nonprofit organization is the primary beneficiary and receives 80 percent of the net proceeds raised from the year's fundraising efforts; the music education partner receives twenty percent. (This amount may be divided simply by the number of music partners, if DIR partners with more than one, or the amount may be based on the stated need request). To date, almost a half a million dollars has been donated to community charities since the program's first event in 2007.

**The application deadline is Saturday, February 2, 2019.** The Doctors In Recital board will review all applications and invite finalists to interview on February 26 or 27, 2019, with the 2020 partners announced by April 11. The 2020 concert will be held on January 18, 2020 at the Weidner Center.

**Note: Doctors in Recital does not support salaries/general office expenses. We also do not support musical instrument repair or purchasing unless it is part of a new educational program.**
